TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

1. The tournament will be conducted under the rules of tennis and the code of conduct approved by Tennis Australia. The committee shall have the entire management of the Tournament and make alterations it considers necessary.
2. **Entry fees must accompany your entry.**
3. A timetable will be used for most of the tournament. Players who do not report at the required time will be **scratched**. Players scheduled for 9 am matches must report by 8.50 am.
The timetable should be available on our web site by mid-morning on the day prior to the start: www.wanglawntennis.com.au
4. Regulation tennis attire must be worn. **Ripple sole** shoes are not acceptable on the grass courts.
5. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to re-grade a player at any time.
6. **Dispute** on any point shall be submitted to the Referee. The Referee or the Tournament Director shall have the power to appoint a deputy, and, failing such appointment, the Committee shall exercise such power in each case where the need arises.
7. **Open matches:** to be the best of 3 sets (match tie-break prior to semi-finals). **Grade** and Junior events to be 8 game sets, tie-break at 7 games all. Junior 10 and under will play a 6 game set, tie-break at 5 games all. All draws are knockout except for D grade doubles and events with limited entrants. In such cases, round-robin or other alternative draws will be used.
8. The Tournament Committee has the authority to vary the length of matches where the need arises.

EVENT LIMITS & RESTRICTIONS

ALL PLAYERS: The following limitations apply:

- › You may enter a maximum of one singles. one mixed doubles. two other doubles (Except for D grade - one other doubles only).
- › You may enter with a different partner in each of your doubles events.
- › Mixed doubles pairs will generally be graded at the strength of the strongest partner.
- › D grade doubles players may elect to play D or C grade singles and mixed doubles.

SENIOR PLAYERS: A player may only enter in consecutive grades; Open + A, or A + B, or B + C

- › Open and A grade players may not enter Veteran events. Veterans events are considered consecutive with B and C grades.

JUNIOR PLAYERS: May play two junior doubles, or one junior doubles and one senior doubles.

Final Day: If a competitor is still in 4 events on the final day, the Committee may scratch the player from any event.

CANCELLATION: The Committee reserves the right to cancel any event or make alterations it deems necessary if the entry numbers are considered insufficient.

AGE LIMITS: Juniors: Age is taken at the 31st January. Veterans: Must be 45 as of the 31st January.

Additional Notes:

- › No alterations or entries after **10am** of the **Monday** prior to the tournament. Contact number for late enquiries: 04 0191 6667.
- › Any player entering 4 events may have a heavy work load throughout the tournament.
- › Mixed doubles events will start at 9am on day two and continue through to day 3.
- › Most events will finish on day three and generally by mid afternoon. Some junior events may finish on day 1 or day 2.
- › Please inform us if a timetable clash arises.
- › Additional tennis will be made available if you are eliminated from all events by 2:15 pm on day 2.
